ACADEMIC EXCELLENCE

- Principal and School Board will seek out funding for professional development opportunities for teachers and staff.
- Teachers and Board will provide additional opportunities for educational travel and field trips.
- Teachers will regularly evaluate curriculum to make sure students are able to fully develop their God-given talents and develop an appreciation for God's creative design.



FAMILY & COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT
